Scope: External ocular photography documents medical progress of the external eye, lids and ocular adnexa. Photographs record conditions and pathology of the adnexa, external eye and anterior segment more accurately than chart notes or drawings. They are used to track changes in abnormal conditions over time.

Clinical Indications:

- To track the progression or lack of progression of an eye condition
- To document the progression of a particular course of treatment
